Pursuant to Rule 26 of the Rules of Appellate Procedure, the opinion previously issued in the above-captioned case is now final and is hereby certified to the Lawyer Disciplinary Board and to the parties. The respondent's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia is hereby suspended for three months. Respondent shall comply with the mandates of Rule 3.28 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure consequent to his suspension, complete an additional six hours of continuing legal education during the current reporting period, including three hours in the area of ethics and office management and three hours in the representation of clients in petitions for writ of habeas corpus, and is hereby ordered to reimburse the Office of Disciplinary Counsel for the costs of this action in the amount of \$2,140.15.
