At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County, on the 22d day of September, 1982, the following order was made and entered, to-wit:

IN RE: John L. Ward, a member of The West Virginia State Bar

This proceeding came on this day upon the report and recommendation of the Committee on Legal Ethics of the West Virginia State Bar, submitting the petition and affidavit of John L. Ward consenting to his disbarment pursuant to the provisions of Article VI, Part E., Section 27 of the By-Laws of the West Virginia State Bar, and moving that an order be entered disbaring the defendant on consent in accordance with the provisions of said article. Upon consideration of which, the Court is of opinion to, and doth hereby, grant said motion.

Accordingly, it is adjudged and ordered that the license of John L. Ward, to practice law in the State of West Virginia, be, and the same is hereby, revoked and annulled.

It is further ordered that the Clerk promptly certify a copy of this order to the Director of the West Virginia State Bar and that a duly attested copy be served upon the defendant, John L. Ward, according to law.
