At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County on the 11th day of July, 1985, the following order was made and entered, to-wit:

16794 In Re: Nancy S. Miller

On a former day, to-wit, July 10, 1985, came the petitioner, the Committee on Legal Ethics of the West Virginia State Bar and presented its Findings and Petition for Suspension, Medical Evaluation and Action under Article VI, Sections 26(b) and (c) of the By-Laws of the West Virginia State Bar and moved the Court to immediately suspend the license to practice law in this State of Nancy S. Miller, a member of the West Virginia State Bar and to order a prompt evaluation of her mental condition by a qualified physician. Submitted with the petition were the order of the Hearing Subcommittee dated July 9, 1985 and the transcript of proceedings before the Subcommittee had on July 8, 1985, with attached Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2, Exhibit No. 2 being the request of the respondent Miller to be suspended until such time as her capacity to practice law has been restored. Upon consideration of all of which the Court is of opinion to, and does hereby, grant said motions.

It is, therefore considered and ordered that the license of the respondent, Nancy S. Miller, to practice law in the State of West Virginia be, and the same is hereby, suspended, effective July 11, 1985, until the further order of the Court, and the respondent, Nancy S. Miller, is directed to report to the office of Dr. Bradley Soule, Route 1, Box 593, Shepherdstown, West Virginia, 25443, for examination at three o'clock p.m. on Tuesday, July 23, 1985, and thereafter at such times and places as Dr. Soule deems necessary to complete his examination and evaluation. Such examination is to be done on behalf

of the Court and Dr. Soule is to make his written report thereof to the Court, addressed to the Clerk, Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia, State Capitol, Charleston, West Virginia, 25305, but Dr. Soule is directed to submit the bill for his services in this behalf to the West Virginia State Bar, State Capitol, Charleston, West Virginia, 25305 for payment pending final taxation of costs in this proceeding.

Service of a copy of this order upon the respondent by certified mail, written receipt requested, shall constitute due notice to her of the contents hereof.
