On a former day, to-wit, September 16, 1994, came the complainant, the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Sherri D. Goodman, its attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.10, Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its written recommended disposition in the above-captioned proceeding, together with a certificate of the expenses and the Hearing Panel Subcommittee Report, recommending that the respondent be publicly admonished and be required to reimburse the Lawyer Disciplinary Board for one-third of the costs and expenses incurred in the investigation and hearing of this matter in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$473.50).

It is further ordered that the respondent reimburse the Lawyer Disciplinary Board one-third of the costs and expenses incurred in the

investigation and hearing of this matter in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$473.50). Chief Justice Brotherton absent.
