On a former day, to-wit, August 4, 1994, came the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Sherri D. Goodman, its attorney, in response to this Court's order entered on the 29th day of June, 1994, and presented to the Court its written response to the petition for reinstatement of the respondent, Pamela Pell Gordon, and its written recommended disposition thereto.

Thereafter, on the 3rd day of October 3, 1994, came the respondent, Pamela Pell Gordon, a suspended member of The West Virginia State Bar, by Gary L. Rymer, her attorney, and presented to the Court her concurrence with the written recommended disposition.

Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to and doth hereby adopt the written recommended disposition of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board. It is therefore ordered that the respondent, Pamela Pell Gordon be, and she hereby is, placed on inactive status until she can obtain employment in a supervised setting, subject to the approval of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, and that respondent practice law in the supervised setting for a period of one year. Chief Justice Brotherton absent.
