On a former day, to-wit, January 10, 1994, came the Committee on Legal Ethics of The West Virginia State Bar, by Sherri D. Goodman, its attorney, and presented to the Court the Hearing Panel Subcommittee's recommendation and the Full Hearing Panel's adoption thereof that the respondent, Paul Cowgill, Jr., be reinstated to the practice of law in the State of West Virginia.
