On a former day, to-wit, December 31, 2003, came the petitioner, Geraldine Roberts, a suspended member of The West Virginia State Bar, by John E. Busch and Richard T. Busch, Busch & Talbott, her attorney, and presented to the Court her petition seeking the reinstatement of her license to practice law in the State of West Virginia.

Upon consideration whereof, the Court is of opinion to and doth hereby grant said petition for reinstatement upon the condition that the petitioner's practice of law be supervised for a period of one year. It is therefore ordered that the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the petitioner be, and it hereby is, reinstated with the condition that the petitioner practice law under the direct supervision of James N. Riley for a period of one year.
