
On a former day, to-wit, January 20, 2004, came the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Rachael L. Fletcher, its counsel, and presented to the Court, pursuant to Rule 3.18 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, its petition seeking the immediate annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, James L.
