ORDER

On December 21, 2015, came the petitioner, David D. Perry, a suspended member of The West Virginia State Bar, by counsel Richard W. Weston, Esq., pursuant to Rule 3.32 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court his petition for reinstatement of his license to practice law in the State of West Virginia.

On June 23, 2017, the Hearing Panel Subcommittee of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by Timothy E. Haught, its chairperson, pursuant to Rule 3.32(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, presented to the Court its written report and recommendation, recommending that the petitioner's license to practice law in the State of West Virginia be reinstated with certain conditions.

Neither consent nor objection to the Hearing Panel Subcommittee recommendation was filed by the parties.

Upon consideration, the Court is of the opinion to and does not concur with the recommendation of the Hearing Panel Subcommittee. It is therefore ordered that the petition for reinstatement is hereby denied.
