
Donald P. Cookman, a member of The West Virginia State Bar, Respondent

On a former day, to-wit, January 28, 2009, came the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Andrea J. Hinerman, its attorney, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its motion for the Court to accept respondent's disbarment by consent together with the formal affidavit of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment.
