ORDER

On May 22, 2017, came the Office of Disciplinary Counsel, by Renée N. Frymyer, Lawyer Disciplinary Counsel, pursuant to Rule 3.25 of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, and presented to the Court its petition praying for the Court to accept the annulment of the license to practice law in the State of West Virginia of the respondent, Thorn H. Thorn, and the formal affidavit, under seal, of the respondent consenting to voluntary disbarment. The Office of Disciplinary Counsel further requests that this Court dismiss the pending statement of charges, Supreme Court Docket No. 16-1225.

Upon consideration, the Court does hereby grant the petition.
